# Space Type Matrix for Full Functionalization

The following room types must be fully functionalized in USpace Survey and can only use the Joint Use function if they were vacant or under renovation for the entire fiscal year. In these instances you must specify which of the two conditions as a note on the room.

<sup>1</sup>Research Labs require occupant, PI, and grant number if any portion of the space is coded to Research.

<sup>2</sup>Research Lab Support ONLY requires PI and grant number if any portion of space is coded to Research. The functions of these rooms generally reflect those of the lab or labs they support. There generally should be no occupant listed in these room types.

<sup>3</sup>Animal Rooms not assigned to DVR should be fully functionalized and ONLY require PI and grant numbers for the portion of the space coded to Organized Research or Other Sponsored Activity/Clinical Trials. If all work in the room is charged out it should be coded as 100% Service Center. There generally should be no occupant listed in these room types.

<sup>4</sup>Office Research spaces require occupant, PI and grant number if any portion of space is coded to Organized Research or Other Sponsored Activity/Clinical Trials. The functions of these rooms generally reflect those of the lab or labs they support. Department must obtain approval from the Office of Space Management prior to using this room type.
